Parent-Children Car Questions

(Things you can discuss on the way home in the car.)

- 1. How do you think Jesus feels about sharing the Gospel in India?
- 2. Is sharing the Gospel sometimes risky? Is it worth the risk?
- 3. Who is supposed to share the Gospel?

Reflection: Jesus calls us to follow Him, which means, in part, a life characterized by love and risk. While some risk is foolish or selfish, risk and service for the Gospel is always worthwhile and pleasing to Jesus.
